

COMPANY NUMBERING AND MARKING LOCATIONS ON UNIFORMS AND ACCOUTREMENTS

The following lists uniform and accouterment items that are to be marked with your assigned Company Rack and Stack Numbers, and the location on each where they are to be marked. Such marking is not mandatory but is encouraged to eliminate confusion of ownership and to aid in the prevention of loss due to theft or accident.

Hat/Cap	inside lining, at rear
Coat	inside rear, at neck
Waistcoat	inside rear, at neck
Shirt	inside rear, at neck
Trousers	inside rear, at waistband
Shoes	inside each, along side
Neck Stock	inside, on leather tab
Cartridge Box	inside sling tab, behind buckle
Cartridge Box Belt	inside, at end
Bayonet Carriage	inside, behind buckle
Scabbards-	on back, at top
Canteen	rear, at top
Haversack	rear, at top
Musket	on escutcheon
Bayonet	on socket, length-wise
Hanger	top of guard, outside, near blade
Hatchet	on rear of head, length-wise
Knapsack	inside shoulder strap, at bottom
Blanket Coat	inside rear, at -neck
Watch Cloak	inside rear, at neck

The manner of marking Company Rack Numbers in all items shall be as follows; (for the number D-1 as an example)
